

## PE and Sports Grant

The Government is determined to secure a significant and lasting legacy from the London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games and to develop children's enjoyment of sport and physical activity from an early age. As such the Government has decided to double the PE and Sports Grant from September 2017. Consequently the Education Funding Agency (EFA) has now agreed a final allocation of £14,010 for this school year based on £8,000 per eligible school plus £5 per eligible pupil from Years 1 – 6 for the 5 months from April to August, rising to £16,000 per eligible school plus £10 per pupil for the remaining 7/12 of the school year.

Details of the PE and Sports Grant allocation for our school for 2016-17 and how we spent it is provided below. These figures have been determined by the Education Funding Agency and provided to Local Authorities.
